The Kansas Rural Center provides a free on-farm service to help you improve beef profits as you exercise good stewardship to protect the water downstream.



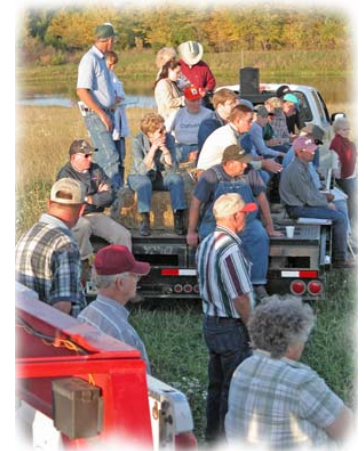
Benefits
